



# ROCKY MOUNTAIN ZENTANGLE RETREAT

## TRAVEL & LODGING INFORMATION

### AIRPORTS

**Colorado Springs Airport:** this is a small airport, easy access in and out, only about 15 minutes to our venue. Because it is small, there are not a lot of direct flights, and often the flights are slightly higher in cost, but it is very convenient. Easy to get a taxi or Uber, or rent a car.

**Denver International Airport:** this is a very large airport, with lots of direct flights to many locations. Flights are often cheaper, but you are about 2 hours away from the venue. There is a shuttle from DIA to Colorado Springs (drop off at airport or a couple hotels), or you can rent a car.

### HOTELS

Colorado Springs is a large geographic area, so there are hotels nearby to the venue, or nearby to the airport, or somewhere else in the city. I am including some of the hotels that are closest in proximity to our venue. The Mining Exchange and The Antlers would be within a mile and would be walkable to the venue. I recommend checking some of the travel sites (hotels.com or travelocity.com etc) to look at amenities, pricing, shuttle availability, reviews, etc.

As I live in the city, I do not stay at the local hotels. So these are strictly offered as an option for you to look at and make a decision based on your own needs.
